*Admissions Requirements for EDU 460B, 460D, 461A, and 461B include: 1. Passing scores on Praxis II content area exam for your area of certification (Middle school Praxis exams do not qualify). 2. A completed application packet. 3. A full-time teaching position in the grade level cluster (1-5 or 6-12) and content area of certification in a state-accredited school. 4. Apply for a Practioner License with the Education Department.

NOTE: Prior to applying for a Louisiana teaching certificate, the candidate must pass the Praxis II Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) exam for their grade level cluster. For students seeking certification in foreign languages, the World Languages Pedagogy must be taken in place of the PLT. Candidates seeking World Languages certification must also pass the Oral Proficiency Interview through Language Testing International (LTI) with a minimum score of Advanced Low Proficiency.
