1. A Completed Application to Program
2. Passing scores on Praxis II Content Subjects Exam. (Middle school Praxis does not qualify)
3. Meet all state requirements for the Practitioner License (Including: Passing II Content Test, Clear Background Credential, Louisiana approved mentor, teacher of record in area of certification and grade cluster in a state-accredited school.)

Completion of Program

Before applying for a Louisiana teaching certificate, the candidate must pass the Praxis II Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) Exam (5624). For **students seeking certification in foreign languages, the World Languages Pedagogy(5841) must be taken in place of the PLT.**
