***Admissions Requirements for EDU 460B, 460D, 461A, and 461B include:**

1. A Completed Application to Program
2. Passing scores on Praxis II Content Subjects Exam. (Middle school Praxis does not qualify)
3. Meet all state requirements for the Practitioner License (Including: Passing Content Test, Clear Background Credential, Louisiana Approved Mentor, Teacher of Record in Area of Certification and grade cluster in a state- accredited school.

Completion of Program

Before applying for a Louisiana teaching certificate, the candidate must pass the Praxis II Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) Exam (5624). **For candidates seeking certification in foreign languages, the World Languages Pedagogy(5841) must be taken in place of the PLT.**
