*In order to obtain add-on certification in Louisiana, the following are required:

1. The candidate must already possess a valid Type A, A* B, B*, Level 3, Level 3*, Level 2, or Level 2* Louisiana teaching certificate, a Master's Degree earned at a regionally accredited college or university, and three years of experience in the licensed or certified field.
2. Candidate must pass Praxis Teaching of Reading: Elementary (5205) or Teaching of Reading: Elementary Subtest (7002).
3. Complete twelve (12) graduate semester hours in reading education as listed below and reflected on official transcripts.
4. Candidate must have a Clear Background Credential from the Department of Education
