UHC RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

MINIMUM GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The following are the minimum requirements expected of all students to successfully complete the UHC Professional Training Component in Radiologic Technology. These requirements must also be met to be eligible for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) certification exam.

- 1. A grade of "C" (77%) must be maintained at the end of each didactic and clinical course and each comprehensive examination. Any failed course or comprehensive exam must have been retaken and passed.
- 2. All clinical written tests, simulations and competencies must be passed with a minimum grade of an 80%.
- 3. Minimum grade of 77% on the 21-month Exit Comprehensive Examination.
- 4. All unapproved absence occurrences exceeding the allotted 80 hours of time off per year must be made up prior to official graduation.
- 5. Completion of all didactic and clinical requirements as specified in the degree program (Associate or Baccalaureate degree requirements.)
- 6. All items borrowed from the program, department, library and/or university must be returned in good order or fines paid.
